What a wonderful year for rescued pets in southwest Missouri. Thanks to your support, C.A.R.E. Animal Rescue surpassed its total number of rescues in 2024... by August! As we enter the final push of 2025, we are now well beyond 1,000 rescues, and thrilled to offer even more animals the second chance they truly deserve.

One recent rescue that stands out is the story of Willow, a severely underweight 5-year-old Chinese Crested mix. Rescued from animal



control in heartbreaking condition, Willow was emaciated, suffering from a painful skin infection, and in desperate need of medical care. Her veterinary evaluation also revealed a wide range of health challenges, including an untreated thyroid condition, allergies contributing to her chronic skin issues, and an antibiotic-resistant staph infection. Thanks to the dedication of her veterinary team and caregivers, Willow began a comprehensive treatment plan which included a prescription diet to address her allergies, thyroid supplementation, and medicine to help manage her itching and inflammation.

Today, Willow isn't surviving, she's thriving. Her skin is healing, her energy has returned, and every day we see more of her sweet, spunky personality.

Another rescue made possible only by your support is that of Alejandro, a handsome 1-year-old male yellow



Tabby who was sealed in a box and thrown from the window of a moving vehicle. Thankfully, a good Samaritan witnessed this heinous act and quickly brought him to C.A.R.E.. Battered and bruised from head to toe, Alejandro also had deep wounds from a separate attack.



Four months later, Alejandro made a full recovery, with the exception of a few forgotten scars, and is now enjoying a much simpler life—one where he no longer fears the hand that feeds him. He spends his days basking in the sun and soaking up every ounce of attention directed his way.

Thank you for giving so many animals the second chance they deserve. Your support is the reason Willow, Alejandro, and thousands of other animals are safe today.

## THIS IS WHY WE FOSTER



When people ask why a busy family like ours fosters for C.A.R.E. Animal Rescue, we tell them it's because—even in the chaos of everyday life—we can always make room for a life that needs saving.

Emergency fostering fits into our world in unexpected little pockets of time, and every new arrival teaches us something different. Even in just a few hours or days, we see the immediate impact of offering safety, comfort, and love. It's incredible how quickly an animal in crisis responds to a warm bed, a gentle touch, or simply knowing they're not alone. Those moments remind us that even small acts of care can change a life forever.

Our fostering journey began with a single animal who needed a place to rest, heal, and feel safe again. We weren't sure at first—busy schedules, kids, routines—but C.A.R.E. made it possible. They provided the support, supplies, and guidance we needed so we could focus on what really matters: giving each animal a soft landing and a chance to start over.

Every foster who comes through our door carries their own story. Some are

timid, unsure of what comes next. Others are ready to love but just need someone to give them a chance. Watching them slowly open up—seeing tails wag again, hearing purrs replace fear—fills our home with a kind of joy that's hard to describe. We get to watch their spirits lift in real time, and it's a privilege we never take for granted.

And of course, there's the moment they find their forever family. It's bittersweet, but mostly sweet. Seeing them leave with people who are excited to love them for the rest of their lives reminds us why we do this. Letting go isn't the hard part anymore—it's the gift we get to give.

Yes, fostering can be emotional and unpredictable. It asks for your heart, even when life is already full. But it also gives so much back. C.A.R.E. rescues animals who deserve a second chance, and fostering lets our family be a part of that hope, even in the busy seasons of life.






## SNOOPY & STEWART

## LIFE-SAVING PARTNERSHIPS

When Animal Control calls, it's usually a situation of life and death. This was the case when a recent investigation required assistance— 20 cats, many of which needed immediate medical assistance, were found living in a car with their caretaker. Thankfully this unexpected rescue came shortly after a wonderful week of adoptions, and we had the exact amount of space for every single cat with the most urgent medical needs!


Knowing time was critical for our nine recent rescues, we rushed them to our vet where they were examined, treated for their infections, cleaned, and given individualized plans to begin their new life with their health and safety as the top priority.



Within months, Czerina, Guinness, Star Lord, Armani, Lucky, Snow White, Nike, Freya, and little newborn, Loki had all been fixed, vaccinated, completed

their treatment and found their forever family!

Winston, a 9-year-old Beagle mix who found himself sitting on death row waiting for his time to expire is another life we are honored to have saved,



thanks to your support and our partnerships! He came to us with a respiratory infection, double ear infection, and a mass on his side. Winston was immediately taken back to our Sanctuary, where he was evaluated, treated for an advanced respiratory infection, and received medication for his double-ear infection.

Once Winston was healthy and bloodwork indicated he was safe for anesthesia, he was back to the vet for tumor removal and sterilization.

After facing possible euthanasia, life-threatening infections, and a potential cancerous mass, today Winston's only surviving scar is his cute "cauliflower" ear caused by an untreated Aural Hematoma prior to joining that CARE family. He is not only surviving, but thriving his new adoptive family.

We are so incredibly grateful for a support system that continues allowing us to remain a steadfast lifeline for more than 1,000 homeless animals every year. Our partnerships, volunteers, foster families, and loyal supporters are responsible for every rescue story, every adoption photo, and every life we have saved since 1992.

## CREATURES GREAT AND SMALL THE STORY OF THUMBOLINA



Our Farm Sanctuary is home to many animals, none more ornery than our goats, each special in their own way. From the towering LaMancha brothers, Woody and Lassi, impatiently waiting for breakfast, to tiny Thumbleina relaxing under her heat lamp, each one arrived needing love, safety, and care. Thumbleina is the same height as the world's smallest recorded goat. Delicate and on daily heart medication, she is still feisty, bright, and full of joy. She came to us as a bottle baby after being unable to nurse. Even with bottle feeding, she wasn't growing or thriving. When we picked her up, she was small enough to fit in a cat carrier. She ate well but couldn't climb or run like a typical kid.

A veterinary exam revealed a heart defect that would worsen as she grew, and when we were told she might not reach her first birthday our hearts sank. Then our insightful veterinarian suggested trying a heart medication commonly used for dogs. We began treatment right away, along with daily vitamin supplements, special chopped hay, and as much love as possible. If her time with us was going to be short, we wanted every moment to count. Thumbleina quickly adored her daily brushing sessions, or "special scratches." She leans in so hard she would topple if we weren't holding her up! She enjoys freshened water, her favorite foods, and slow, curious walks around the farm. Though there is no cure, her medication greatly improved her heart function. To our delight, she grew stronger and learned to trot and play. She prefers not to be with other goats, even the smallest are three times her size, so she befriended companions closer to her own size, bunnies and chickens. We are grateful for every precious moment with this little miracle. Thumbleina may stand only 15 inches tall, but she is a giant part of our Farm Sanctuary family.
